Welcome from the Derby Co-Chairs

I would like to welcome everyone to the 34th Annual Owen Sound Salmon Spectacular on behalf of my fellow cochairs and the Sydenham Sportsmen's Association.

Last year, we experienced a scaled down event in keeping with the Grey Bruce Health Unit and the Province of Ontario's COVID-19 Mandates. There was no live entertainment and themed days such as, Kids Day and Seniors Day were cancelled. We could not enjoy our "fisherman's breakfast" with Elvis or tap our toes to the incredible music by the Beckett Family. Though they were greatly missed, the derby was still run safely and successfully.

We had 21,000 people pass through the tent and 2900 fish were entered over the course of the 10 day event.

Our fabulous fish fries were distributed by a curbside drive thru resulting in a huge success as we served well over 2100 fish dinners over the course of the 2 Saturdays.

This year, we are pleased to go forth with our full-scale Salmon Spectacular only bigger and better.

We welcome back the entertainment and community focused theme days along with the regular dine in tent style fish fries. Our food concession, bar and merchandise booth will be operating as usual. We have confirmed the popular Fishing Friendzy pond where we will be holding the first annual fishing derby in the Molson Coors and Liuna Local 1059 Derby tent for Kids 16 years of age and under.

We would like to thank you for your continued support making it possible to host this grand event. Your support directly aids our hatchery and stocking programs which in turn, provide the healthy fish you catch in the derby. Many other projects of the Sydenham Sportsmen's Association benefit greatly as well. Last year, we were able to complete two waterfowl pond digs in partnering with Ducks Unlimited, as wetlands are disappearing at an alarming rate across the Province.

Planning the Owen Sound Salmon Spectacular is a 52-week process with countless hours spent advertising, preparing the popular Outdoor magazine, logistics and acquiring the necessary sponsorships. We advertise and attend different Outdoor and Fishing shows across Ontario, also advertising through radio, television and print.

Our dedicated committee and volunteers are the backbone of the Salmon Spectacular and they have our utmost respect and extreme gratitude. We simply could not put on the derby without them.

We are excited for the growth of the Salmon Spectacular over the years. It is endearing to see people that have fished the derby as youngsters now bring their own children out to experience this family friendly event. 2022 OWEN SOUND SALMON SPECTACULAR™ RULES AND REGULATIONS

<u>GENERAL</u>

- 1. The OWEN SOUND SALMON SPECTACULAR™ runs from 12:01 am., Friday, August 26, 2022 to 12:00 Noon, Sunday, September 4, 2022
- All participants agree to abide by the Regulations of the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Act, The Fisheries Act, The Department of Transport "Small Boat Safety Regulations," and the Rules and Regulations of the OWEN SOUND SALMON SPECTACULAR™.
- 3. A contestant may only enter the number of fish permitted by the daily creel limit in any one day (no matter when caught).
- 4. Each contestant upon registering to compete in the OWEN SOUND SALMON SPECTACULAR™ agrees to hold the sponsors, organizers, their agents and employees harmless from any liability of any nature and kind for any injuries and/or damages suffered during or after the period of the contest, by entrants.
- 5. Derby Ticket purchases can be made at any of our retail outlets, or on-line at https://www.sydenhamsportsmen.com/the-derby/online-ticket-sales. All on-line Derby tickets can be printed at the time of purchase by the person ordering the Derby Ticket. Single registration tickets are \$30.00 and Family registration tickets are \$70.00. Methods of payment online are: VISA, MasterCard and PayPal. PLEASE TAKE A PICTURE OF YOUR COMPLETED DERBY TICKET. We will not be looking for lost tickets. There are no REFUNDS!
- 6. Tickets purchased during the derby are not valid for participating in the derby on the day of sale. (A Derby ticket becomes valid the day after it is purchased!)
- 7. Family tickets are available for all members of the immediate family, including children 17 years of age and under. (Children's age is determined as of the date of ticket purchase). The Family Derby Ticket does not include grandparents, older brothers and sisters, grandchildren, as well as other relatives. The participant agrees that the decision of the Officials is to be final on all matters.

FISHING

- Participants must angle only in the waters of Georgian Bay stretching from the downstream side of 10th Street bridge on the Sydenham River and the walking bridge on the Pottawatomi River at Kelso Beach, the Sykes S. bridge on the Big Head river, the mouths of Beaver River, Indian Brook, Indian River, Bothwell's Creek and inside the boundary extending to a point 10mi (16km) directly north of Delphi Point, then to the Cape Croker Lighthouse.

- Fish caught only after legal derby registration, and caught within the boundaries per rule #9, and caught during the OWEN SOUND SALMON SPECTACULAR™ (see Rule 1.) may be entered.
- 10. Only fish that are whole (not gutted) may be entered. Fish with a snag or foul hook mark, gaff or gill net mark, even if caught legitimately, will not be accepted. Previously frozen fish may not be entered.
- 11. Entrants fishing from boats must ensure that all other occupants of their boat, regardless of age, are entered in this event, and be eligible to enter fish (refer to Rule 6.). Entrants must fish with only one rod per person at any time.
- 12. Participants agree to allow official representatives of the derby to inspect their boats to ascertain that all occupants are entered, and that all persons in the boat are holding a valid ticket.
- 13. Participants agree that the organizers may, at their discretion, hold any fish for biological examination and testing.

FISH ENTRY (WEIGHING IN)

- 14. Fish will only be weighed at the Official Weigh-In Station at the Georgian Shores Marina. The weigh-in station will be open from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. daily, except the last day of the Derby, when it will close promptly at 12:00 Noon. Fish will not be weighed outside of the times indicated, except those entrants who are waiting in line by closing time will be allowed to have their fish weighed after closing time.
- 15. Salmon and trout (Rainbow, Brown, and Lake trout) must weigh a minimum of three (3) pounds (1.36 Kg), to be eligible for entry in the OWEN SOUND SALMON SPECTACULAR™. A printed receipt will be issued for each fish entered.
- 16. All participants entering a fish must sign the official entry book at the end of the weigh-in station. By signing the entry book you are stating that you agree with all the registration information regarding yourself and the fish you are entering (species, weight) that is shown in the official weigh-in station records and the receipt.
- 17. Each entered fish will have its gill plate punched, to prevent re-entry.
- 18. Owen Sound provides the angler with clean water and edible game fish. Any angler found guilty of wasting his catch will be disqualified from the OWEN SOUND SALMON SPECTACULAR™. Any angler disqualified for this reason will have all prizes forfeited.

PRIZES

- 19. One Random Daily Prize will be drawn for each of the categories (i) male, (ii) female (iii) child (age 17 and under). The weigh-in station computer will draw by random selection for each fish entry.
- 20. The Derby has various random draws throughout the event for prizes
- 21. Grand Prizes will be awarded for the heaviest Salmon, the heaviest Rainbow trout, the heaviest Lake trout. The heaviest Brown trout will have a separate prize. A complete prize list is posted at the Derby Headquarters and on our website at www.sydenhamsportsmen.com
- 22. All Prizes must be accepted as awarded. The Grand Prizes must remain decaled as presented for at least one year from presentation.
- 23. Each of the winners of the heaviest Salmon, the heaviest Rainbow trout, the heaviest Lake trout will receive a replica mount. The winners, in accepting these prizes, agree to allow the Sydenham Sportsmen's Association unlimited use of said mounted fish for promotional purposes until the conclusion of the subsequent Derby Awards Ceremony (September 3, 2023).
- 24. Prizes will be awarded daily for the 10 heaviest Salmon and 5 prizes will be awarded daily for the heaviest Trout.
- 25. In the event of a tie, prizes in question will be awarded on the basis of the earliest fish entered.
- 26. All participants agree, upon winning a major prize that they will submit to validity tests, if required, and will sign an affidavit confirming the fact that their fish was caught within the rules of the contest.
- 27. Prizes not picked up by October 31, 2022 will become the property of the Sydenham Sportsmen's Association.
- 28. Any participant guilty of an infraction of the rules will be disqualified from the contest, and any prizes will be forfeited.
- 29. Early Bird Prizes 1st -Sportspal Canoe, 2nd Sit-In Kayak and 3rd -Lowrance Graph will be awarded from all Derby Tickets purchased up to and including Saturday August 6, 2022. Early Bird Prizes will be awarded along with all other derby winners on Monday September 5th, 2022.
- 30. Grand Prizes will be awarded for the heaviest Salmon, the heaviest Rainbow trout, the heaviest Lake trout, the heaviest Brown trout, the boat for all derby ticket entries on the final awards day Sunday September 4, 2022 from 3 pm to 6 pm. The Boat and Recreational Draw will take place at 5:40 pm.
 31. The Owen Sound Salmon Spectacular will be following all COVID-19 Safety Guideline procedures and recommendations laid
- out by the Grey Bruce Health Department. Failure to adhered to the OWEN SOUND SALMON SPECTACULAR™ rules at the time of our event could lead to removal from the tent and possibly disqualification from the derby. Please follow the rules that are set in place at the time of the event from August 26 To September 4, 2022.
- 32. All Prizes will be handed out on Monday September 5, 2022 at the Stow-it Self Storage 1960 20th Street East Owen Sound, ON N4K 5P1.
