

Judging: Done by audience vote? Panel of Judges? Which of you wants to be Simon Cowell or Sofia Vergara?



Range Events

Numerous sanctioned events such as Trap, Skeet, Cowboy Action and Precision Rimfire have been added to the "All Events Calendar" on the SSA Website. Please check the SSA website for dates, times and Co-Ordinator's. Guest for these events, are always welcome.

This year SSA will be hosting a Youth Day and the Tentative Date is June 1st and we are looking for volunteers to help on the 22 Rimfire and 100 Yard Range. Last year we had a great turnout and support from our members. It was lots of fun and everyone appeared to be having a great time. If you are interested in helping on Youth Day with Supervising young shooters using 22 Rimfire Firearms (firearms are provided by SSA) please let Trevor Dollmaier know. This is a great opportunity for us to promote safe shooting with our youth.

Training

For our new members, we have an SSA Orientation Tour Scheduled for January 28th. This orientation is a requirement to be able to use the Archery and 22 Cal Rimfire Range on your own. The Orientation is a prerequisite for any other range courses offered at SSA. Other Orientation Tours will be available and will be posted on the SSA All Events Calendar.

To use the Handgun Range, a Holster or the 100 Yard Range unsupervised you must complete a specific training course. These training courses will be starting soon. Please contact the Range Co-ordinators to get your name on the list. We would like to get our members that want to use these ranges qualified as soon a s we can. Once we get enough participants, we will schedule the courses. Starting this year, all members that bring guests that use SSA Range facilities will see a change to the Guest Waiver Form. It is the responsibility of the SSA Member to ensure that the information block below (which is at the bottom of the Guest Waiver Form) is filled in completely and is legible on their first visit to each range.

On each visit, the bottom part of the block needs to be filled in and initialed by the sponsoring member for that visit. Please ensure that the \$5.00 Guest Fee is placed in the Donation Box for each use of the range. Donation boxes are located at each range.

PAL / RPAL numbers are required and if one is not available then the member sponsoring the guest is responsible for Direct and Immediate Supervision of the guest, and for ensuring that the guest is following the SSA Range Rules.
