
Early Bird Membership

Most of the regular – winter AND summer - Shooting activities are returning on their normal schedules to the ranges in 2024. The calendar is just beginning to fill in with trap and skeet shooting events that are in addition to regular range days, as well as precision rimfire rifle shooting, handgun proficiency training, cowboy action shooting, and

There will be a spring and fall cycle of Handgun Proficiency Training days lead by Chuck Cannon again in 2024. This training sold out fast in 2023, so keep your eye on the calendar in early February when registration will go live on our website. (The tentative dates for this training are already posted.) IF you want to learn and practice your handgun proficiency skills from a holster – this is the course for you.

NEW IN 2024 – an exciting initiative also lead by Chuck Cannon – is the 2024 SSA Youth Outdoor

Adventurer's Program! This program is planned to begin in April 2024 targeting youth between the ages of 12 to 18, and will include interactive activities focused on learning about navigation, rifle marksmanship, archery techniques, shotgun shooting, first aid and survival skills, wildlife identification, hunting and fishing skills, and more! The club is very happy to support this program financially – but like everything at our club it requires members to volunteer time to help lead these modules. Chuck's vision can only become reality with your help – and the idea is to get members who have practical experience in any one of the above subject areas to help lead the modules.
