TThe Guest Speakers for this meeting will be Nancy Brown and Carl Sadler of the Inglis Falls Arboretum.






Turkey Shoot





SSA Fish Hatchery---M Prevost

We are in the process of waiting for the river and fish run conditions to cooperate so the Lake Huron Fishing Club can collect our quota of 120, 000 Rainbow eggs. Back around April 8th conditions were good and the LHFC collected over 100,000 eggs in one day and they were able to collect 90,000 eggs for the Bruce Peninsula Sportsmen's Club the next day. Unfortunately for us when it was our turn to come up to bat conditions changed and on the 12th we were only able to pick up a little over 12,000 eggs. Fortunately the LHFC is a determined group so it is only a matter of time now.
