Fisheries Report---M Prevost


Fish Hatchery Operations/ Salmon Egg Collection

Our Salmon egg collection this year has proven to be a struggle and disappointing. Through four attempts we were able to collect 76,000 eggs. Unfortunately the Lake Huron and Sarnia clubs were only able to collect 15,000 eggs. All of us short of our 110,000 egg collection allocation. This is the first year that our clubs have not met our egg collection target. For a definitive answer on why I guess you would have to ask the fish. Like anything else there is never just one answer but a combination of factors.

It is deceiving to see fish below the dam and even more up the river in Harrison Park and think that maybe we missed the run. I think if you asked the locals and tourists the viewing run was generally a disappointment. On the few days that you could see the salmon below the fish ladder the water temperature was too warm to collect the fish, a temperature regulation set under our permit by the MNRF to help ensure that the eggs we do collect are viable. No use collecting eggs if they are just going to die off and there was a week of unseasonably warm weather around the Thanksgiving Weekend.

I think the most notable factor was the high percentage of female Salmon we collected that were not ripe so we could not strip any eggs from them and had to release them.

On our best day of collection we handled 81 fish; 43 of these were females and only 5 were ripe with eggs. If 30 of those females had been ripe we could have collected our allocation in one day. Hopefully we and the fish will work things out better next year.
